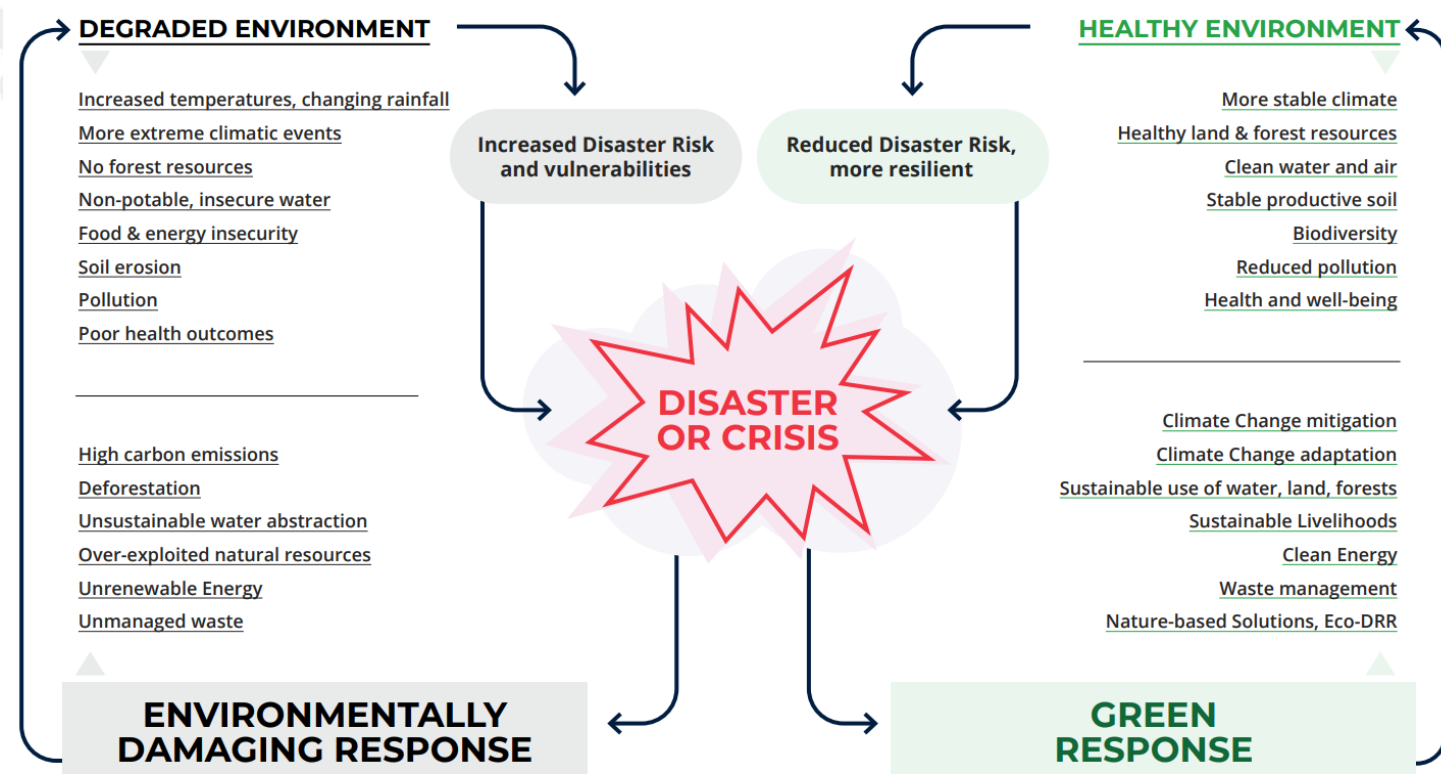

Carbon Accounting in the humanitarian sector: Why and what for?

The link between the environment, disasters, and humanitarian response



ADRA Network coalition

- 2018: Preparation started
- 2021:
 - Carbon Reduction Guide
 - Cooperation between ADRA Germany and Canada (official signatories of Climate Charter)
- Embedded in programmatic strategy and aligned with *ADRAs Network Environmental and Climate Change Policy* (April 2022)



ADRA Network Environmental and Climate Change Policy

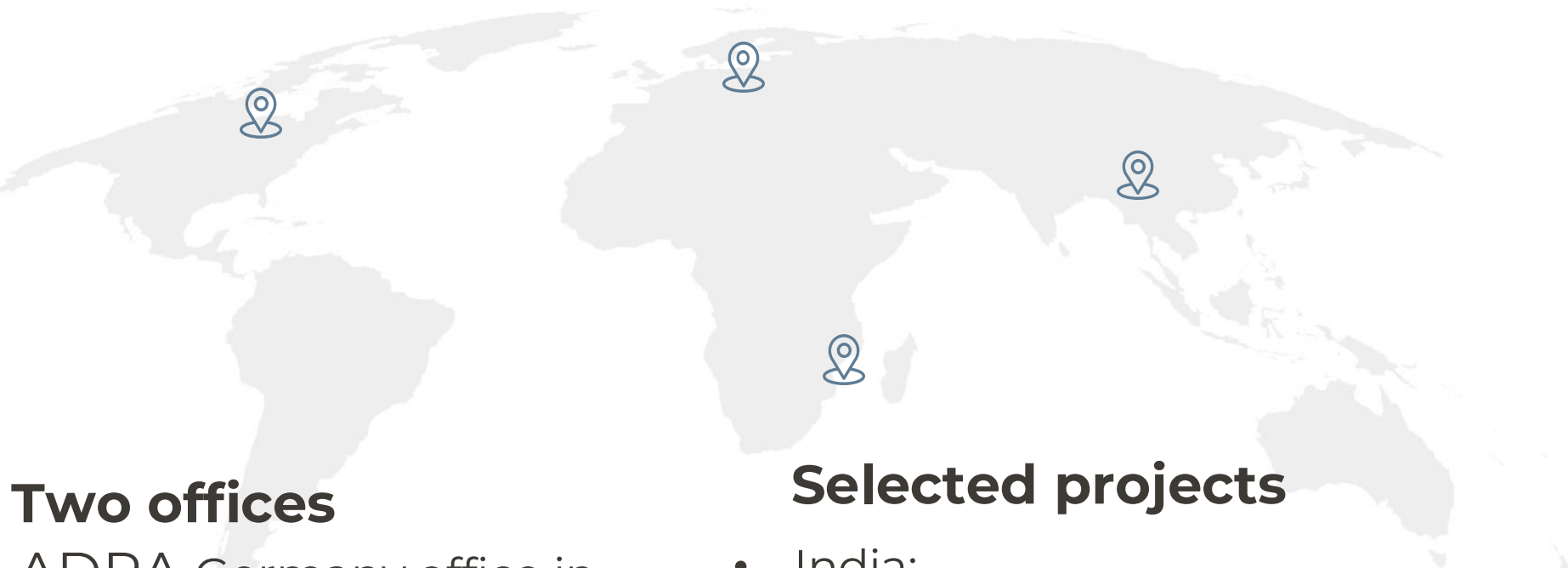
- Need to act in an environmentally responsible way to confirm Adra's Stewardship of God's creation
- To ensure ADRA Network expands its commitment of "do no harm"
- Green ADRA operations
- Improve the resilience of communities and ecosystem



Overview

Objective: Carbon Reduction is integrated in programs and projects of ADRA Germany and ADRA Canada - “greening humanitarian aid”

- **Test Carbon Accounting Tool** commissioned by ICRC
- Exchange with **network of 25 humanitarian NGOs** (ICRC, Oxfam, MSF, Action for Hunger,...)
- **Timeframe:** July 2022 – July 2023
- **Main activities:**
 - Create system for carbon accounting integrated in programs and in the development of new programs/projects
 - Gather data and train ADRA staff on collection



Two offices

- ADRA Germany office in Weiterstadt
- ADRA Canada office in Newcastle

Selected projects

- India:
Assam ECHO flood response
- Mozambique:
Zambezia Inclusive and Resilient Food Security (ZIREF)
