






## WARNING: TREATED SEED!











2. DO NOT TOUCH TREATED SEED. ALWAYS USE PROTECTIVE GLOVES AND MASKS.



3. AFTER PLANTING, WASH YOUR HANDS AND FACE BEFORE EATING, DRINKING, SMOKING OR GOING TO THE TOILET.



4. KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.



5. DO NOT LEAVE ANY TREATED SEED ON THE SOIL SURFACE. PICK UP ANY SEED THAT HAS SPILLED OR REMAINS ON THE SOIL SURFACE, BURY IT IN THE GROUND AND COVER IT WITH SOIL.



**6.** DO NOT REUSE THE BAGS OR LEAVE THEM LYING AROUND.



7. DISPOSE OF EMPTY SEED BAGS PROPERLY: BURN THEM IN THE OPEN AIR FAR FROM PEOPLE AND HOMES AND KEEP YOURSELF AND OTHERS AWAY FROM THE SMOKE.
