**Remark:** National IHL Competition 2021 (Thai Round) concluded without issues, which was a good indicator of the feasibility of a completely online Role Play and Moot Court Competitions. The Competition received engagement mostly from the usual pool of universities, with a good level of engagement, considering the situation, judging from numbers of original applications (18 teams). There was one team from Payao University that participated for the first time. However, due to withdrawal or lack of participation during the memorial phase, the numbers of actual participating university teams were 10 and 8 as aforementioned.
