# International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)

## Activities Highlights

Ukraine crisis. August 2017

Over 480 staff members based in Kyiv, Donetsk, Luhansk, Mariupol, Sloviansk, Sievierodonetsk and Odesa.



## Health Care

67

**primary health care facilities** on both sides of the contact line received chronic disease medications for treatment of patients with cardiovascular diseases.

3

**training sessions** were conducted for 42 persons providing psychosocial support at community level (*Helping the Helpers*).

115

**people** residing along the contact line participated in 74 mental health support sessions.

40

**hospitals** were provided with medications, dressing materials and various medical equipment to treat wounded patients.

62

**wheelchairs** were donated to social facilities in Donetsk.

14,300

**vials of insulin** were donated for diabetic patients in Luhansk.



## Caring for the dead

135

**body bags and 10 coffins** were donated to CIMIC Body Search and Recovery team.

25

**representatives of National Police, Forensic Services, DNA laboratories and CIMIC** participated in workshop on collection of information from relatives of missing persons for identification purposes.

200

**body bags and other self protective equipment** were donated to the Body Search and Recovery team in Donetsk.



## Armed & Security Forces

38

**UAF officers** participated in two seminars on IHL and ICRC.

50

**law enforcement officers** took part in two sessions on IHL and Use of Force.

12

**police officers** in Luhansk region participated in a seminar on detention process and international rules and standards for policing.



## Water & Habitat

3,720

**litres of bottled water** were delivered to residents of Berdianske village due to a major water pump failure.

2,600

**residents** of 17 localities on both sides of the contact line received construction materials for structural rehabilitation of their damaged houses.

4

**educational institutions and 1 medical facility** received construction materials for infrastructure rehabilitation.

23,500

**litres of fuel** were donated to *Voda Donbasa* in the form of vouchers for company's fleet as a part of emergency assistance.

1

**First aid point** was installed at Stanytsia Luhanska crossing point and connected to electricity supply.



## Cooperation with the URCS

215

**vulnerable people** were assisted by URCS home-visiting nurses, with the financial support from the ICRC.

147

**URCS volunteers** participated in EcoSec's and WatHab's programmes implementation.

220

**people** participated in 14 First Aid trainings facilitated by volunteers of the Local Red Cross in Luhansk, with the financial support from the ICRC.

over  
90,000

**people** were assisted by URCS volunteers and feldshers at Stanitsa Luhanska crossing point, with the financial support from the ICRC.

73

**URCS staff and volunteers** took part in one First Aid training and two ERT meetings, with the financial support from the ICRC.

**The URCS sub-office** in Kramatorsk was renovated, with the financial support from the ICRC.



## Economic Security

15,000

**people** received 17 kg food parcels each.

15,000

**people** received essential hygiene items such as soap, washing powder and shampoo.

1,150

**school kits** were provided for children residing in villages along the contact line.

740

**people** were supported with cash assistance (1,651,000 UAH) for their livestock recovery activities. **Over 360 people** were trained on how to better manage their livelihoods.

over

16,000

**chickens and 18 tons of animal fodder** were donated to over 1,800 people.



## Detention

6

**places of detention** were visited, and the situation of **48 detainees, including 5 newly registered**, was monitored. **15 short oral and written messages** were exchanged between detainees and their families.



## Family Links

12

**families** of missing persons received cash assistance.

On the International Day of the Disappeared in Kyiv, the ICRC unveiled an **art installation "No news, but I don't believe..."** dedicated to those missing in connection with the Ukraine crisis. Events for the families of the missing were also held in other ICRC offices.



## Mine Risk

133

**people** took part in 10 *Mine Risk Education* sessions, **over 2,900 Mine Risk Education posters and leaflets** were distributed.

1,000

**marking signs, 700 metal rods, 24,000 m of fencing and 1,500 m of soft wire** were provided to the local structures in Krasnyy Partizan.

3

**people** injured in mine or other explosive remnants of war incidents received cash assistance.
