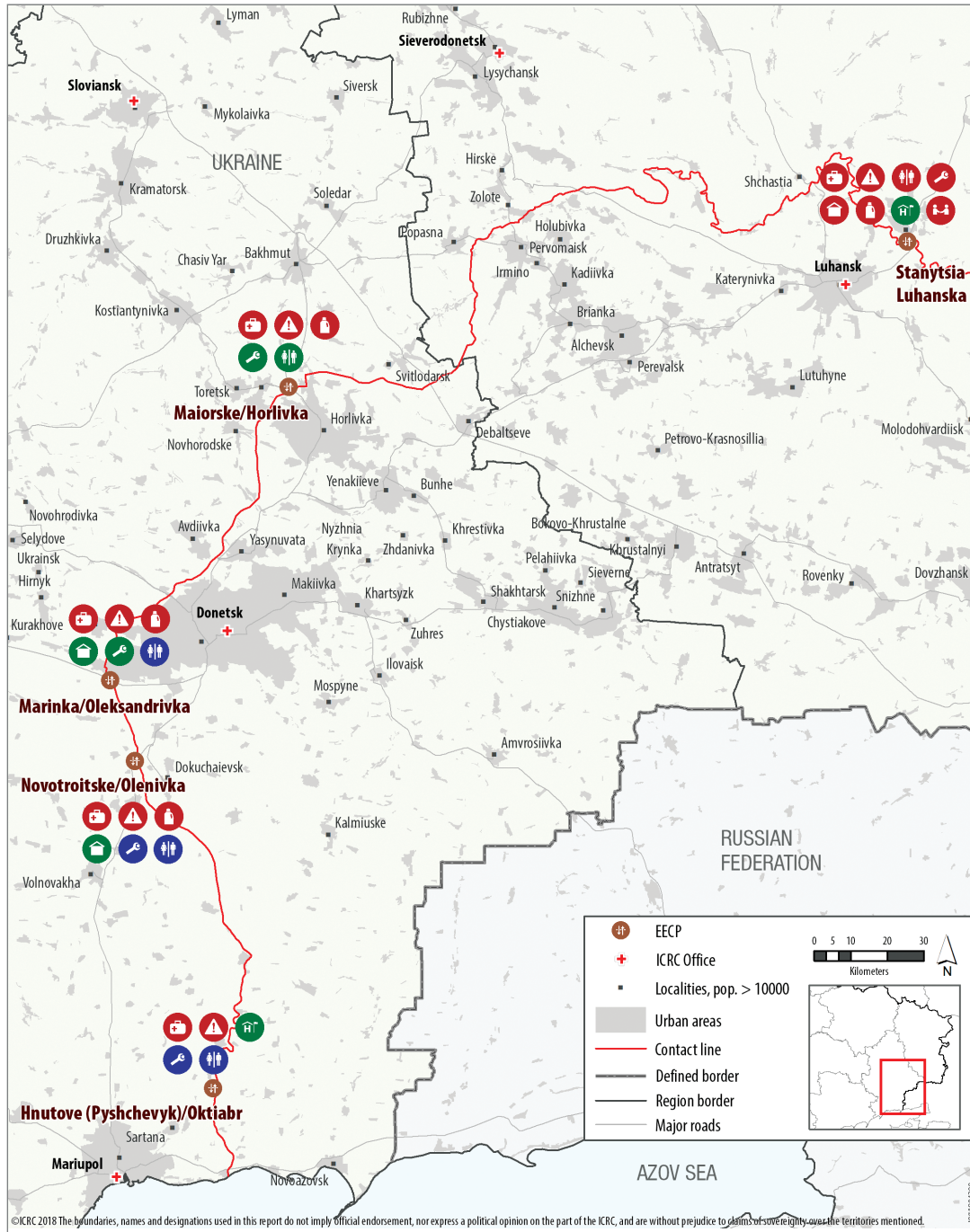




ICRC Assistance at Entry-Exit Crossing Points

January – June 2018

ICRC



- 1 heating/cooling point to enhance comfort for people crossing was prepared for installation at Maiorske crossing point.
- 3 containers for heating/cooling points were provided for improvement of infrastructure at Olenivka, Horlivka and Oleksandrivka crossing points.
- over 466,000** people were assisted at the Red Cross heating/cooling points on both sides of the bridge at Stanytsia Luhanska by volunteers and staff members of the Red Cross.
- 1 back-up petrol generator was provided to Olenivka crossing point.
- 2 bus stops were installed at Hnutove and Novotroitske crossing points.
- 20 waste containers were provided to Oktiabr, Olenivka and Oleksandrivka crossing points.
- 4 crossing points in the NGCA were provided with medical items: first aid kits, dressing sets, stretchers, sets for respiratory resuscitation and medical couches.
- 7 automated external defibrillators were donated to five crossing points.
- 1 kit of essential medicines and equipment was supplied to Maiorske crossing point, ensuring provision of first aid and essential primary medical care.
- 3 new mine awareness billboards were installed and a preventive fence was replaced at Stanytsia Luhanska crossing point.
- 12 new bio-toilets and two water tanks were donated to Oktiabr and Olenivka crossing points.
- over 140,000** tea bags, 369,000 of cups and glasses, 1,200 kg of sugar and 20,000 litres of bottled water were provided for heating/cooling points.
- 60,000 sets of disposable tableware along with detergents were provided for Stanytsia Luhanska crossing point.
- To improve the situation for civilians, who often have to wait for many hours exposed to heat or cold when crossing the contact line, the ICRC installed **heating/cooling points** equipped with heaters and air conditioners for people to rest.
- Red Cross volunteers** are present at Red Cross heating/cooling points on both sides of the bridge at Stanytsia Luhanska every day to provide water, hot beverages, and first aid.
- The ICRC helps make conditions surrounding the passage of the crossing line less harsh through construction of **shades**, installation of **bus stops**, provision of **waste containers** and **water tanks**, maintenance of **latrines** and partial **rehabilitation** the existing civilian **infrastructure**.
- Installation of **first aid posts** in order to facilitate provision of medical aid at crossing points.
- Provision of first aid kits, medicines, automated defibrillators and other **medical items** to facilitate provision of first aid at crossing points. In addition, medical staff were trained in basic life support.
- Increase of preventive measures at crossing points by installing **warning signs**, **billboards** and **portable toilets** so that people unaware of the hidden danger posed by mines and unexploded ordnance stay on the road while waiting in queues.
- Improvement basic services for people queuing to cross by providing **water**, **tea**, **sugar**, **disposable tableware** and **detergents**.
