



Water and Habitat

 over **300,000** people in the Donetsk region are assured of reliable and steady access to drinking water after a full rehabilitation of the **Karlivska Pumping Station**.


 over **4,000** residents of Popasna were provided with sustainable access to potable water thanks to the opening of two new water towers that replaced a damaged one and were installed with support from the ICRC.

 over **148** tons of **liquid chlorine** for water purification were procured for the main water and sewage company of the Luhansk region with financial support from the ICRC.

 **27** localities on both sides of the contact line benefited from donations of water treatment chemicals to the main water and sewage companies of the Luhansk and Donetsk regions: **965 tons of sand, 830 tons of aluminium sulphate, 110 tons of activated carbon**.

 **36,000** litres of **potable water** were distributed to the residents of Avdiivka during disruption in operations of the Donetsk Filtration Station.

 **3,500** teachers and children benefited from the installation of **protective sandwich panels and anti-blast film** on windows and the **improvement of facilities** of 26 schools and kindergartens on both sides of contact line.

 over **5,000** people benefited from the donation of construction materials and the improvement of facilities of **11 medical institutions** on both sides of the contact line.

 **6,000** residents of 46 localities on both sides of the contact line benefited from donations of **tools and construction materials** (PVC windows, plastic sheeting, tarpaulin, timber, cement) for the rehabilitation of damaged houses, including emergency repairs.

Family Links


 **76** families of missing persons received cash assistance.


 **68** new tracing requests for persons unaccounted for were received.

 **44** tracing requests were closed. **691 cases of missing persons** registered with the ICRC since the beginning of the conflict remain active.


 **7** families received **transportation assistance** to reunite with a family member separated as a consequence of the armed conflict.


Economic Security

 over **127,000** people on both sides of the contact line received 17kg **food parcels**, which include buckwheat, rice, pasta, flour, sunflower oil, sugar, canned beef and sardines, tea and yeast.

 over **127,000** people on both sides of the contact line received **hygiene parcels** containing essential items such as soap, washing powder and shampoo.

 **25,000** households were supported with 70 tons of animal feed, 162 greenhouses, 41,000 chickens and cash grants to help them **restore or maintain their productive assets**.

 **245** households in the GCA are restoring their income-generating capacities thanks to cash assistance for livestock or crop management.


 over **9,300** people in the GCA received **monthly cash assistance** to cover their basic needs.


 over **600** households were supported with **cash** to insulate their houses and prepare themselves for harsh **winter conditions**.


 **46** families of people injured or deceased due to the conflict were provided with cash assistance in the GCA.


 **94,000** people benefited from donations of **in-kind assistance and essential household items**: firewood and coal, insulation kits, LED lamps, candles, mattresses.


Health Care

 **51** hospitals on both sides of the contact line were supported with **medicines, intravenous fluids, dressing materials and other medical items** to provide medical care to the weapon-wounded and the sick.

 **52** primary health care facilities on both sides of the contact line received chronic disease medicines.


 **2** blood banks were supported with reagents and blood bags, securing production of more than **20,000 blood product units**.


 **2** rehabilitation centers were supported with raw materials for prosthetic production, training equipment and furniture items.

 over **140,000** **flacons and cartridges of insulin** were donated to medical facilities to cover the needs of patients with diabetes.

 **126** relatives of missing people were provided with **psychosocial support**.









 **1,200** people residing along the contact line received **psychosocial support** during 889 group sessions and home visits.

 **460** health, social and community workers learned how to provide psychosocial support during 52 training sessions.

 **372** URCS staff and volunteers improved their **first aid skills** during 27 training sessions, supported by the ICRC.

Caring for the dead

-  **31 forensic institutions** on both sides of the contact line were supported with specialized and self-protective **equipment**.
-  **2 body search and recovery teams** on both sides of the contact line received **technical equipment**.
-  **4 morgues and one genetic lab** were **refurbish and reconstructed** on both sides of the contact line.
-  **300 experts** took part in five **workshops**, two **information sessions** and three **round tables** organized by the ICRC to strengthen the identification process and promote IHL obligations towards the dead.
-  **12 forensic practitioners and law enforcement representatives** were supported to participate in forensic courses abroad.
-  **21 families** of missing persons were informed about the forensic identification process.
-  **2 bodies** were **exhumed** with participation of the ICRC.
-  **3 families** were supported with covering of **funeral expenses**.






Detention

-  **248 detainees**, including **105 newly registered detainees**, were visited by ICRC delegates in 22 places of detention in the GCA.
-  **129 short oral and written messages** were exchanged between detainees and their families.
-  **500 prison personnel** per year can now be trained on standards of the treatment of detainees in the **classroom refurbished** and opened by the ICRC in the Bila Tserkva penitentiary staff training center.
-  **208 penitentiary workers and civil society activists** participated in six **training sessions** on international standards for the treatment of detainees, conducted by the ICRC.
-  **40 penitentiary doctors** improved their skills in providing first aid during two training sessions organized by the ICRC.






Armed Forces

-  **470 UAF personnel** participated in **16 seminars** on IHL and the ICRC.
-  **210 law enforcement officers and scholars** participated in **nine seminars** on international rules and standards for policing, IHL and other related topics.


Mine Risk

-  **3,400 people** on both sides of the contact line participated in 113 mine risk education sessions.
-  **2,600 children** on both sides of the contact line attended mine risk performances.
-  **9,000 mine risk education posters and leaflets** were distributed to people residing along the contact line.
-  **40 demining specialists** learned how to provide first aid for people with **blast trauma** during **two courses** conducted by the ICRC.
-  **1,300 marking signs, 110 rolls of marking tape, 1,000 wooden poles** and other supportive equipment were distributed to the relevant structures on both sides of the contact line.
-  **9 mine risk billboards** were installed along the roads approaching Stanytsia Luhanska crossing point in the NGCA.

Cooperation with URCS

-  **170 Red Cross volunteers** participated in joint distributions of aid, repair of houses, implementation of first aid, psychosocial support, risk awareness and safer behavior programmes.
-  **460 elderly people living alone**, including persons with disabilities, on both sides of the contact line were assisted by **94 Red Cross home-visiting nurses**, supported by the ICRC.
-  **11,000 patients** residing in villages close to the contact line were assisted by **four URCS mobile clinics**, with the support of the Finnish Red Cross and the ICRC.
-  **21 puppet shows** were organized in Avdiivka by URCS volunteers to provide psychological relief for local children, with the support of the ICRC.
-  **50 volunteers** participated in nine **ERT missions** during mass gatherings in Ukraine with financial support from the ICRC.

Logistics

-  **5,250 metric tons** of humanitarian aid, including 29 tons of health care aid, were delivered to people on both sides of the contact line by 363 trucks.
